**1. APOLOGIES**

**2. MINUTES**

**RESOLVED** that Minutes 1 to 4 of the Annual Parish Meeting held on 16 April 2012 be approved as a correct record.

**3. COMMUNITY REPORT**

A report from the Town Clerk on the previous year's activities and future projects was noted. The Town Mayor thanked the Town Clerk and Council staff for their hard work in the past year.

**4. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION**

There were no electors from the Parish of Penryn present at the meeting, however, Caroline Robinson of the Falmouth Car Club Supporters Group attended the meeting and was given permission to address the Council. She advised Councillors of plans by Cornwall Council for a Car Club to service Falmouth, Penryn and Truro which was a scheme to provide pool cars for hire by annual subscription of around £200–300 per year, and a small hire charge of £4–6 per hour inclusive of fuel. It was intended that it would be a pilot scheme for the whole of Cornwall. Ms Robinson was advised to write to the Council formally requesting its support for the scheme.
