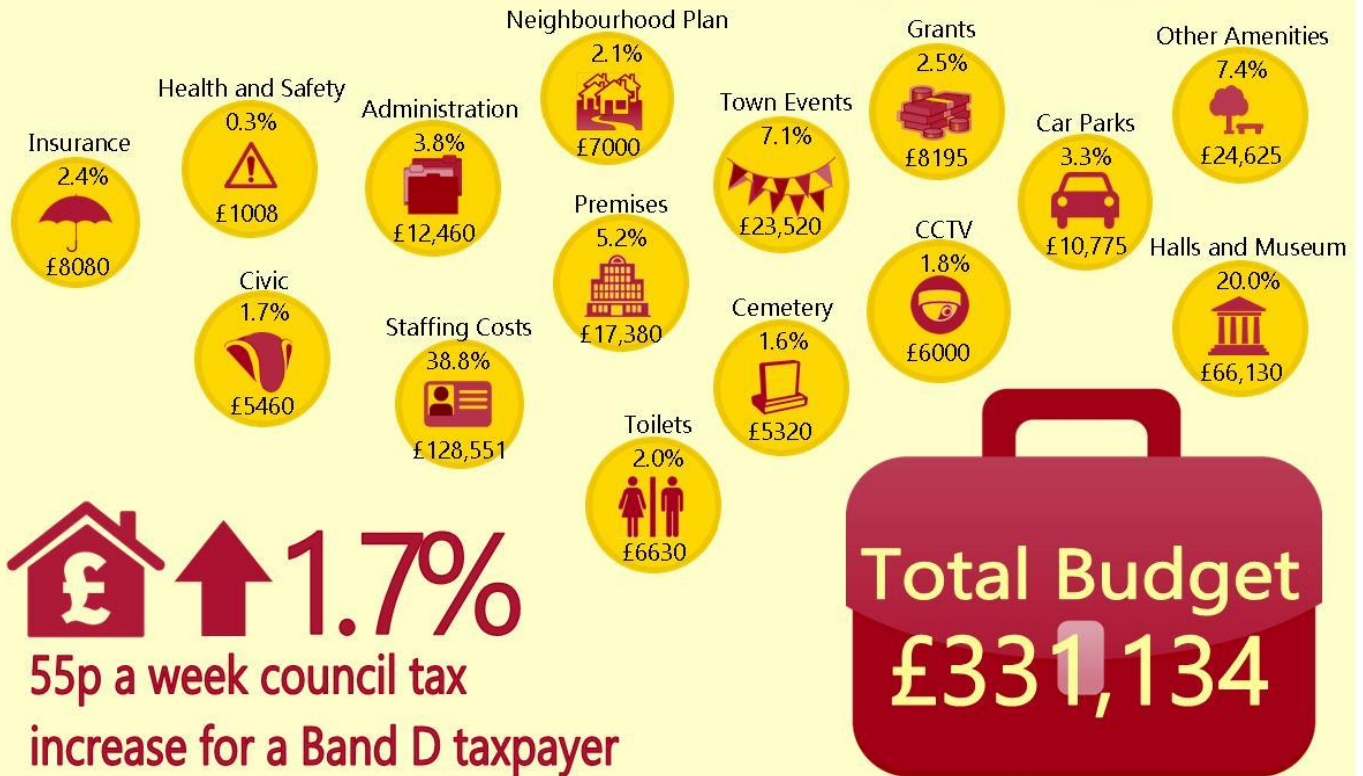




Penryn Town Council Annual Budget 2016-17

How will the council's budget be spent?



This year's budget will allow the Town Council to continue with its bid to take on a number of assets and services from Cornwall Council to safeguard them for the future. These include the library, Permarin, Commercial Road and Saracen car parks, Glasney Playing Field, College Field, the land beneath the Bowling Club and provide a youth service.

Additional projects next year include repairs to the clock tower to address problems with damp, development of a Neighbourhood Plan and a sizeable budget has been set aside for the celebration of the town's 800th anniversary. The CCTV will be back in operation in the town centre with a greatly improved service.

The budget also includes running of the museum and subsidising the halls ensuring a very reasonable rate can be charged to residents and community groups. The Town Council also maintains footpaths and verges, Doorstep Green in Glasney Valley, benches, floral displays and bus stops.
