NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

for the Penryn Neighbourhood Plan

1. A Referendum will be held on **Thursday, 19th August 2021** to decide the question:

“Do you want Cornwall Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Penryn to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. Applications to register to vote or to vote by post or proxy should be made to the Electoral Registration Officer at 3rd Floor, South Wing, County Hall, Treyew Road, Truro, TR1 3AY based on the deadlines set out below:

New applications to register to vote. Applications can be made online: www.gov.uk/register-to-vote	12 midnight on Tuesday 3 August 2021
New applications to vote by post or to cancel or amend an existing postal/proxy vote	5 pm on Wednesday, 4th August 2021
New applications to vote by proxy	5 pm on Wednesday, 11th August 2021
Applications for an emergency proxy vote (in cases where unforeseen illness, incapacity, occupation, service or employment occurs after the deadline for proxy applications). The physical incapacity must have occurred after 5 pm on Wednesday, 11th August 2021. To apply on the grounds of work/service, the person must have become aware that they cannot go to the polling station in person after 5 pm on Wednesday, 11th August 2021.	5 pm on Thursday, 19th August 2021
